Sir,

On the subject cited above I am hereby
submitting you the report of Kulwant Singh aged
35 years s/o Sadha Singh c/o Central Jail
Amritsar.

As per record Pt. was admitted to
Surgical Emergency (Unit I) by Emergency
Medical Officer on duty on 3/8/10 at 3.10 PM
with provisional diagnosis of -

1)Dyspnoea with odema face, eye and both
legs.

2)H/O self strangulation attempt.

3)History of police torture.

Pt. was initially given treatment by
Surgical Unit I and then pt. was shifted to

prisoner duty ward (Surgical Unit IV) in the evening.

Investigation of the patient revealed Kidney failure. Ultrasound report of abdomen was done on 9.8.10 from Civil Hospital Amritsar as the ultrasound machine at G.N.D. Hospital was out of order and arrangement for U/S was done by the Central Jail. The report of ultrasound shows Renal Parenchymal disease. For kidney failure opinion from Nephrology Deptt was sought and they advised dialysis of the patient. Dialysis was done by the Nephrology Deptt and as a result of treatment patient improved significantly.

X-ray of both legs and feet showed fracture of 5th metatarsal right side with chip fracture of cuboid bone. Opinion from Orthopedics emergency (Unit III) was sought. Orthopedic doctor confirmed the fractures and advised to raise the limb and apply crepe bandage alongwith antibiotics and pain killer. As a result of treatment and advise of Orthopedic Surgeon patient is improving.

X-ray chest of the patient was got done and it revealed patchy consolidation in both the lungs. For that opinion of Medical

Prisoner Duty Ward (Medical Unit III) was taken. Who advised oxygen inhalation, antibiotics and nephrology opinion. Pt. improved with all the above treatment. On 9.8.10 at 23.50 hrs pt. suddenly developed severe hypertension (BP 200/120 mm of Hg), chest discomfort and restlessness. Immediately call was sent to Intensive Care Unit and Medicine Deptt. They advised immediately shift the patient to Intensive care unit. Patient was shifted immediately to Intensive Care Unit and is still in the intensive care unit. As a result of treatment in the ICU patient is improving. His latest parameters are as follows at 2.00 PM.

Pulse - 114 per minute
BP - 165/101
Respiratory rate-On T-piece respiration
Oxygen saturation- 100%
Temp - 100.6F

Pt. is being given oxygen therapy in Intensive Care Unit.

Photocopy of his bed head ticket is being sent to you alongwith this report.

He was admitted in Jail Hospital-II ASR on 2.8.10 at 8.30 PM. According to record available in the Medical manual on 3/8/10, he was suffering from following complaints.

- (1) Oedema on face 4(Rt)Eye Alru
- (2) Oedema on both arms & forearms
- (3) Oedema of both legs
- (4) H/O diarrhea
- (5) Dependency in respiration.

He was referred to Civil Hospital ASR for
